
Environmental Monitoring Strategy Public Engagement Survey Results

Question # 1 – Have you heard about Kawartha Conservation?


> 91% of responses had heard about Kawartha Conservation and only 9% of responses had not.

64% of responses are permanent residents and 36% of responses are seasonal residents of the Kawartha watershed.




Permanent vs Seasonal


Question # 3 – What age group do you belong to?


Age of Survey Participants

> 47% of responses live along a shoreline within the Kawartha watershed.


Shoreline vs Land

Shoreline Distribution


> Of the 53% that do not live along a shoreline, 92% of them live in an urban centre environment, the distribution of where is shown below.



Urban Settlement Distribution


Question # 5 – Are you familiar with any of our current environmental programming?

> Just slightly under 50% of the survey participants said that they were familiar with our current environmental programs.



Program Awareness

Out of the 26 responses who said "Yes" to being familiar with our environmental programming, water quality and aquatic sampling were two of the most recognized with temperature and groundwater monitoring being less familiar. Other areas in which we were known for included snow survey monitoring, conducting research with the Lake Scugog Stewards and Lake Management Plans.

Question # 6 – What do you believe are the biggest environmental concerns facing the Kawartha Watershed today?


Survey responses for this question were tallied and grouped into similar categories. As displayed in the graph below, water quality and development concerns across our watershed is the biggest concern, followed by aquatic plants, flooding/water levels, and loss of fish habitat/stocking.

Question #7 - Moving forward, what types of environmental information would you like to see being gathered across the Kawartha Watershed?


Water Quality information was also at the top of the list when asked the question what environmental information you would like to see being gathered moving forward. The collection of fish information came in second with biological assessments and aquatic plant information coming in third. Based on the survey results for this question the continued reporting of user-friendly data was also ranked very high amongst the survey responses.



Environmental Information Moving Forward


Question 8 – How would you like us to share the information being reported?

Most survey responses would like to see data reported seasonally. The use of interactive dashboards to access real time data was also suggested to report data.




Reporting Timeline


Question 10 - Would you be interested in volunteering?

> Out of the 53 responses, there were 24 people interested in volunteering and 29 not interested.




Volunteer Interest

The age group 45-64 had the most interest in volunteering at 54%, while the age group 35-44 followed at 25%.




Volunteer Interest by Age Group
